Second Week of Easter

On the **Second Sunday of Easter**, as we celebrate **Divine Mercy Sunday**, we get a picture into how the early community lived their life of faith by sharing everything in common.

In John's Gospel, Jesus appears to the Apostles, hiding in fear, and gives them the gift of his Spirit, calling them to forgive sins. We are reminded that the gospel is written, that we might come to believe in our Lord and have life in his name.

The **Acts of the Apostles** all this week offers us the challenges the apostles faced from the earliest communities and from the Jewish authorities.

For the remaining five weeks of the Easter season, our readings will be from the **Acts of the Apostles** and from **John's Gospel**, which offers stories of Jesus' ministry not heard during the Ordinary Time of the liturgical year.

The weekday readings begin with the frightened Pharisee, Nicodemus, coming at night to speak to Jesus, asking how anyone can be "born again."

Jesus says we must be born of water and Spirit. The gospel offers a poetic look at light and darkness, good and evil:

"the light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light...But whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God."

John writes,
 "For the one whom God sent speaks the words of God."

Jesus feeds the 5,000 people. Alone in a storm, the disciples are afraid -- but more fearful when Jesus walks across the water toward them.

"It is I. Do not be afraid," Jesus tells them.

On the **Third Sunday of Easter**, **Luke's Gospel** has the very human story of Jesus' appearing to the disciples after the Resurrection, inviting them to touch his hands and feet to see that he is real.

He ate with them and
 "he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures."

2021-2022 Faith Formation Program Details

Grades 1-6 Hybrid Classroom Model:

Students will attend an in-person class one time per month (Tuesday or Wednesday) from 4:00 PM-5:15 PM ; then complete online assignments for rest of the month. If COVID conditions improve, we will move to all in-person classes with no online assignments.

Grades 1-6 Family Faith:

Parents will teach children the monthly lessons at home with the assistance of online resources.

Students will also attend one half hour Zoom session for **7 months on Sundays after the 11:30 AM Mass** (times will be assigned by grade)

Families will attend 2 family retreats during Advent and Lent from 12:30 PM-3:00 PM on assigned Sundays

Grades 7-8:

Students will complete monthly assignments and community service & attend one in-person class per month (Tuesdays from 7:00 PM-8:15 PM)

If COVID conditions improve we will adjust in-person attendance accordingly.

Grade 9 Immediate Confirmation Prep:

Students will meet one time per month for an in-person session

(Sundays starting at the 11:30 AM Mass until 2:00 PM) along with community service assignments.

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday

as decreed by St. John Paul II.

We will have both the exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament along with the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at the Mercy Hour of 3:00 pm.

This Feast of Divine Mercy, as recorded in the diary of Saint Faustina, receives from Jesus himself the greatest promises of Grace related to the Devotion of Divine Mercy.

Specifically, Jesus states that the soul that goes to Sacramental Confession within eight days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday and receives Holy Communion on that Sunday, shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and pardon from all temporal punishment due to sin.

Additionally, Holy Mother Church grants a plenary indulgence, observing the usual rules with the recitation of some simple prayers.

"This Feast emerged from the very depths of My mercy, and it is confirmed in the vast depths of my tender mercies. Every soul believing and trusting in My mercy will obtain it." (Jesus' words.)

SPONSOR LETTERS

Canon (Church) Law states that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, fully-initiated Catholic (Confirmed).

An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly, by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a genuine Christian lifestyle. Please note that we can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.
