**Below are our Covid-related Chapel Guidelines**

**SPONSOR LETTERS**

Canon (Church) Law states that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, fully-initiated Catholic (Confirmed).

An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly, by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a genuine Christian lifestyle. Please note that we can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

**ARE YOU REGISTERED ?**

We have people coming to Our Lady of Lourdes on a regular basis who need a form of some kind filled out and, when we check our records, we find that they are not registered parishioners.

**ARE YOU REGISTERED AS A PARISHIONER OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES?**

If you are not, it becomes more complicated if you need some kind of form to be filled out stating that you are a parishioner. The best way for you to know that you are registered is the fact that you receive collection envelopes, either on a regular basis or only at Christmas or Easter.

## PENTECOST SUNDAY

Sunday is the great feast of **Pentecost** - the birthday of the Church.

The formerly frightened Apostles are on fire. Now they can speak clearly, so everyone can understand them. Jesus gives his peace to his disciples and breathes his Spirit upon them, giving them the mission to forgive and sending them to carry out his desire that we all be one.

**Lord, send out your Spirit,  
and renew the face of the earth.**

Monday is the **Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church.**

The return to "**Ordinary Time**" doesn't mean we forget about the good news of the Resurrection or the gift of the Spirit Jesus promised us. It simply means that we return to a season of reflecting upon the scriptures with "**numbers**" (*ordinal*) until Advent begins on December 2.

During the week, we resume reading **Mark's Gospel** where we left it when Lent began. It offers us stories about sacrificing part of ourselves. We hear of the Rich Young Man:

**"Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me."**

At that statement, his face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions. Peter tells Jesus,

**"We have given up everything and followed you."**

Jesus responds, **"there is no one who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands for my sake and for the sake of the Gospel who will not receive a hundred times more."**

When the disciples squabble over who will sit in glory with Jesus, he tells them, **"the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many."**

Bartimaeus, a blind man recognizes Jesus as "**Son of David**" and is healed. Bartimaeus follows Jesus.

He drives money changers out of the Temple saying,

**"My house shall be called a house of prayer ... but you have made it a den of thieves."**

We end the week with Jesus evading the trickery of the chief priests who ask him **"by what authority are you doing these things?"**

The week closes with **Trinity Sunday**, which always follows Pentecost.

It celebrates the un-knowable relationship between the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit - and their loving support for us in our lives.

**2021-2022 Faith Formation Program Descriptions**

**Grades 1-6 Hybrid Traditional Model:**

Students will attend an in-person class one time per month (Tuesday or Wednesday) from 4:00 PM-5:15 PM ; then complete online assignments for rest of the month.

**If COVID conditions improve, we will move to all in-person classes with no online assignments.**

**Grades 1-6 Family Faith:**

Parents will teach children the monthly lessons at home with the assistance of online resources.

Students will also attend one half hour Zoom session for 5 months on Sundays after the 11:30 AM Mass (times will be assigned by grade)

**Families will attend 2 family retreats during Advent and Lent from 12:30 PM-3:00 PM on assigned Sundays**

**Grades 7-8:**

Students will complete monthly assignments and community service & attend one in-person class per month (Tuesdays from 7:00 PM-8:15 PM)

If COVID conditions improve we will adjust in-person attendance accordingly.

**Grade 9 Immediate Confirmation Prep:**

Students will meet one time per month for an in-person session

(Sundays starting at the 11:30 AM Mass until 2:00 PM) along with community service
