**OLL'S ADORATION CHAPEL HAS REOPENED**

We are happy to announce that Eucharistic Adoration at OLL was transferred from the Main Church to our Adoration Chapel on June 1st!

**Our current schedule is:**

**Mon., Wed., Thurs. & Fri.-9am to 9pm;  
Tues-7am to 9pm; Sat.-6:30am to 4pm;  
Sun-NO ADORATION.**

**As you can see from our Tues. & Sat. schedules, adorers have begun to return. Please pray that more people of all ages are inspired to join/rejoin our Adoration family.**

Below are the Chapel's covid-related guidelines, which have been updated as of 5/28/21:

- Adorers who have been fully vaccinated do not need to wear masks while in the Chapel unless they prefer to do so.
- Adorers who have not been fully vaccinated should wear masks while in the Chapel. They also should observe proper social distancing.
- The Chapel's air conditioner has been cleaned & serviced. The Chapel windows will be closed while it is operating.
- Instructions on the use of the monstrance cover will be provided to adorers.
- Chapel occupancy is restricted to no more than 4 people at any one time, with seating limited to 4 places spaced according to proper social distancing.
- The Chapel door will be locked at all times. Door code will be provided to adorers.
- No sign-in book will be used.
- Hand sanitizers & wipes will be available for adorers' use. Each adorer is asked to wipe her/his seating location before leaving the Chapel.
- No books or devotional items will be in the Chapel. Adorers are free to bring their own & then take them back home.
- **Please do not leave Mass cards, greeting cards, rosaries, pamphlets or any other materials in the Chapel or Chapel vestibule.**

**SPONSOR LETTERS**

Canon (Church) Law states that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, fully-initiated Catholic (Confirmed).

An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly, by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a genuine Christian lifestyle. Please note that we can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

## Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Sunday in the US is the  
**Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.**

For the rest of the world, it is the  
**Tenth Sunday of Ordinary Time.**

**"If a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand."**

Friday is the  
**Solemnity of Most Sacred Heart of Jesus,**  
with its own special readings.

Saturday is the  
**Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.**

We begin a two-week cycle of readings from Paul's **Second Letter to the Corinthians**, as he confronts the challenges to this early Christian community.

We have ended our readings from Mark for this Liturgical Year and take up the **Gospel of Matthew**, which will be part of our readings until Advent.

The week begins with the beloved teaching of the Beatitudes, found at the beginning of the **Sermon on the Mount.**

The Kingdom of God belongs to the lowly, the peacemakers, those persecuted. These words are some of the most familiar of all the gospels.

Jesus urges us to not hide our gifts under a bushel basket but to recognize that **"you are the light of the world."**

Jesus transforms what the people had been taught.

We are to go beyond not killing; we are to love our enemies.

He tells us that he has

**"not come to abolish laws but to fulfill them."**

Jesus tells us that if we haven't forgiven someone, we should leave our offerings on the altar and go forgive those with whom we need reconciliation.

He speaks about adultery saying,

**"If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one of your members than to have your whole body thrown into Gehenna."**

By the end of the week, we hear Jesus encouraging us to live honestly, making elaborate promises and oaths unnecessary.

**"Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes,' and your 'No' mean 'No,'"** he says.

The words we use are less important than the life we lead. Sunday begins the **Eleventh Week in Ordinary Time**, when Jesus compares our faith to the mustard seed. Our faith, like that tiny seed, can grow large and put forth large branches touching those around us.

**2021-2022 School Year Registration**

**2021-2022 Faith Formation Program Descriptions**

**Grades 1-6 Hybrid Traditional Model:**

Students will attend an in-person class one time per month **(Tuesday or Wednesday) from 4:00 PM-5:15 PM ;** then complete online assignments for rest of the month.

**If COVID conditions improve, we will move to all in-person classes with no online assignments.**

**Grades 1-6 Family Faith:**

Parents will teach children the monthly lessons at home with the assistance of online resources.

Students will also attend one half hour Zoom session for **5 months on Sundays after the 11:30 AM Mass** (times will be assigned by grade)

**Families will attend 2 family retreats during Advent and Lent from 12:30 PM-3:00 PM on assigned Sundays**

**Grades 7-8:**

Students will complete monthly assignments and community service & attend one in-person class per month **(Tuesdays from 7:00 PM-8:15 PM)**

If COVID conditions improve we will adjust in-person attendance accordingly.

**Grade 9 Immediate Confirmation Prep:**

Students will meet one time per month for an in-person session **(Sundays starting at the 11:30 AM Mass until 2:00 PM)** along with community service assignments
