Twelfth Week in Ordinary Time

On the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time we hear the story from **Mark's Gospel** about the storm at sea.

Jesus calms the sea and asks,

"Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?"

Monday is the **Memorial of the Jesuit Saint Aloysius Gonzaga**. Thursday is the **Solemnity of the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist**, with special readings.

Luke's Gospel shows us the deep faith of Elizabeth and Zechariah as their newborn son is named John.

"All who heard these things took them to heart, saying, 'What, then, will this child be?' For surely the hand of the Lord was with him."

call of Abram and his wife Sarai. Abraham and Lot leave each other, splitting land and herds. God makes a covenant with Abraham, who has no heir, and promises him not only a son, but that he would be the father of as many people as the stars of the sky.

This week we continue reading from **Matthew's Gospel**.

Jesus continues his challenge to follow him more completely.

"Stop judging, that you may not be judged."

"Do to others whatever you would have them do to you."

"Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing."

"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the Kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven."

"Who do you say that I am?"

When a leper asks if Jesus will cure him, Jesus replies,

"I will do it. Be made clean."

On Saturday, Matthew quotes the prophet Isaiah,

"He took away our infirmities and bore our diseases."

On the **Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time** we hear the wonderful story of the healing of Jairus' daughter. In the middle of that story is the beautiful story of the healing of the woman with a hemorrhage. He said to her,

'Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be cured of your affliction.'

Jesus tells Jairus,

Do not be afraid; just have faith."

When the girl was healed the people

"were utterly astounded."

ARE YOU REGISTERED ?

We have people coming to Our Lady of Lourdes on a regular basis who need a form of some kind filled out and, when we check our records, we find that they are not registered parishioners.

ARE YOU REGISTERED AS A PARISHIONER OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES?

If you are not, it becomes more complicated if you need some kind of form to be filled out stating that you are a parishioner. The best way for you to know that you are registered is the fact that you receive collection envelopes, either on a regular basis or only at Christmas or Easter.

PLEASE – save yourself and our parish staff a great deal of time and trouble --Visit the PARISH office and register!

SPONSOR LETTERS

Canon (Church) Law states that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, fully-initiated Catholic (Confirmed). An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly, by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a genuine Christian lifestyle. Please note that we can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

**It's Time for Faith Formation**

REVEREND JAMES V. TETI

The Reverend James Vincent Teti was born on November 28th, 1970 in Summit, New Jersey to Vincent E. Teti and Katherine I. Ursitti. After attending public schools in South Orange and Mendham, he graduated from Delbarton School, Morristown in 1988. In 1992 he completed college studies at Yale University, New Haven, Connecticut, earning a B.A. in political science. It was then he began formal studies for the priesthood.

After studying for one year at Immaculate Conception Seminary at Seton Hall University, Father Teti was assigned to the Pontifical North American College, Vatican City. He earned a Baccalaureate in Sacred Theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University, Rome in 1996. He was ordained to the priesthood at Sacred Heart Cathedral Basilica on May 24, 1997. He completed his Licentiate in Sacred Theology from the Gregorian University in 1998, specializing in fundamental theology.

Father Teti has served as a parochial vicar at Our Lady of the Lake Church, Verona and Saint Teresa of Avila Church, Summit.

On December 22nd, 2008 Archbishop John J. Myers named Father Teti the sixth pastor of the Church of the Annunciation located in Paramus, NJ.

In addition to his assignment as pastor, Father Teti is now completing his service as the Director of Selection and Formation for the Permanent Diaconate in the Archdiocese of Newark, being named to the position in 2006 by Archbishop Myers.

Father's Day Novena (20 June through 29 June)

Happy Father's Day. Today we pray for our Fathers, Grandfathers and Godfathers living and deceased. Below is a reflection on Christian Fatherhood by Pope St. John Paul

Within the conjugal and family communion-community, the man is called upon to live his gift and role as husband and father. Love for his wife as mother of their children and love for the children themselves are for the man the natural way of understanding and fulfilling his own fatherhood. Above all where social and cultural conditions so easily encourage a father to be less concerned with his family or at any rate less involved in the work of education, efforts must be made to restore socially the conviction that the place and task of the father in and for the family is of unique and irreplaceable importance. As experience teaches, the absence of a father causes psychological and moral imbalance and notable difficulties in family relationships, as does, in contrary circumstances, the oppressive presence of a father, especially where there still prevails the phenomenon of "machismo," or a wrong superiority of male prerogatives which humiliates women and inhibits the development of healthy family relationships.

In revealing and in reliving on earth the very fatherhood of God, a man is called upon to ensure the harmonious and united development of all the members of the family: he will perform this task by exercising generous responsibility for the life conceived under the heart of the mother, by a more solicitous commitment to education, a task he shares with his wife, by work which is never a cause of division in the family but promotes its unity and stability, and by means of the witness he gives of an adult Christian life which effectively introduces the children into the living experience of Christ and the Church.

As you can see from our Tues. & Sat. schedules, adorers have begun to return. Please pray that more people of all ages are inspired to join/rejoin our Adoration family.

Below are the Chapel's covid-related guidelines, which have been updated as of 5/28/21:

- Adorers who have been fully vaccinated do not need to wear masks while in the Chapel unless they prefer to do so.
- Adorers who have not been fully vaccinated should wear masks while in the Chapel. They also should observe proper social distancing.
- The Chapel's air conditioner has been cleaned & serviced. The Chapel windows will be closed while it is operating.
- Instructions on the use of the monstrance cover will be provided to adorers.
- Chapel occupancy is restricted to no more than 4 people at any one time, with seating limited to 4 places spaced according to proper social distancing.
- The Chapel door will be locked at all times. Door code will be provided to adorers.
- No sign-in book will be used.
- Hand sanitizers & wipes will be available for adorers' use. Each adorer is asked to wipe her/his seating location before leaving the Chapel.
- No books or devotional items will be in the Chapel. Adorers are free to bring their own & then take them back home.
- **Please do not leave Mass cards, greeting cards, rosaries, pamphlets or any other materials in the Chapel or Chapel vestibule.**
